Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for taking the time to review this important information regarding the Student Resource Scheme (SRS) at Holland Park State High School.

The education of students in Queensland state schools is a shared partnership between families and the Government. Under the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (Qld), the cost of instruction, school facilities, and general administration is funded by the State. However, this funding does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks, personal equipment, and items that are used or consumed in the classroom. These are normally the responsibility of parents and caregivers and, when purchased individually, can place a significant financial burden on families.

To support our community and reduce these costs, Holland Park State High School offers a Student Resource Scheme. By bulk purchasing through approved government suppliers, the school is able to provide quality resources at a considerably reduced cost compared to individual retail pricing.

Participation in the SRS is entirely voluntary. Families who choose not to participate will be required to supply all necessary textbooks, resources, and materials for their student for the full school year.

The Student Resource Scheme operates in accordance with the Department of Education's policies and is endorsed annually by the P&C Association. Flexible payment options are available, and if you are experiencing financial difficulty, please contact our Finance Business Manager to discuss confidential support arrangements.

We value your partnership and look forward to working together to ensure every student has access to the resources they need for a successful year of learning.
