- A school wide focus on writing, commencing with the trial of Write That Essay PD and implementation in Year 8
- Foster healthy attitudes to learning through development and implementation of a Resilience initiative, Growing Stronger Together
- A school wide Focus on Learning How to Learn, to teach students effective learning strategies
- Provision of student support through Homework Club, employment of Teacher Aides in classrooms, purchase additional EAL/D teacher time and employ a Head of Department to lead initiatives to support writing and NAPLAN.
